Dear families,

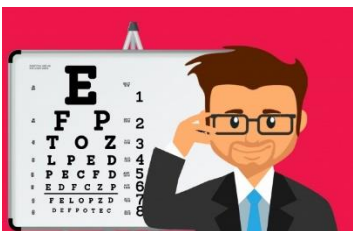
